MINUTES OF MEETING Tuesday, March 5, 2019

**Meeting called to order @ 7:30 pm by Steve C, President. Thank you for coming out on a rainy night!**

Count **38** members present.

**Trivia Questions** None tonight due to club business discussion

**Opening Message** Thank you to Lois F, for creating membership cards for the club. Please come to the meeting to pick up your membership cards for 2019. Thank you to Bob S for having the business cards made for the club with Rydell on the back as our sponsor, everyone take some and pass them out when you see Corvette enthusiasts. Steve mentioned Randy went to Rydell for service and with the discount saved \$450.

**Approval of Minutes from Last Meeting: Cheryl S, Secretary:** Moved to approve: F William, Seconded by AJ. Minutes approved.

**Treasurer, Bryan P.** Went over actuals and expenditures from last year and the Board wanting to use budget amount and residual to enhance the celebration of the 35<sup>th</sup> Anniversary when having other events. Secretary to send files to club members to review. Steve C mentioned we may have a surcharge at some events to offset costs.

**Guest & Member Recognition: Steve R,** announced Birthdays, Anniversaries and Club Anniversaries and there were some significant ones from 9 to 17 years. Steve said he periodically goes to PO Box. He read a letter of gratitude from Hometown Heroes for our donation to their camp for children who have lost a father/mother while in action. It explained the meaning of having a camp where other children losing a loved one can be together and understand their loss.

**Club Business- Steve C** said by next meeting we will vote on charities and how many to support for the year.

**Karen P** presented on behalf of Simi Valley nonprofit spay and neuter clinic. She talked about the number of surgeries conducted over the first year, the immediate past year and the overall number of 95,235 spays/neuters conducted. They have branched out to SF Valley and Kern County. She read an article from the Acorn about the clinic and passed out copies for members. **Steve F,** told of how he was so impressed by the young man who presented for Hometown Heroes initially and how he found comfort from the camp and being with others losing a loved one.

**Steve C** talked about the suggestion of one charity, and others talked about having more than one, maybe even all three that were presented. **Lois F** mentioned if we raise enough it can be split. **Brett R,** gave the example if we split the amount raised last year, each charity would receive \$800. **Cheryl S** mentioned we are not a charity, but a social club, but if we are going to support a charity(s) we need to do so. The example of how far the funds go when sending packages to troops, the sending a child to camp, spay/neuter clinic, etc were discussed. Ballots will be at next meeting to vote on charity(s).

Cheryl S talked about **brochure** created to give out at Rydell and for members to promote club. Steve C talked about stands he will obtain to have at each salesperson's desk, service and financing at Rydell to hold brochures and business cards. Expect to have 20 new members this year. Would like to have Rydell and other speakers at second meeting of each month to discuss car subjects.

Cheryl talked about **T-shirts** and provided sign up sheet for amount, size and selection of design. If we have 40 orders we can spread the cost of the artwork over all and it reduces cost. Avi at BVI said that would be a significant order. Asking whether we can order Ladies and V-neck shirts as well. **Jackets** were available by Kathy T and Joanna R to try on from BVI as alternatives to the satin jackets. Kathy said zipper split when trying on, so when purchasing make sure to check out garment before it is embroidered as Savi is not responsible. Cheryl mentioned some people want to buy their own jackets elsewhere and have them embroidered. Requisite is a "black" jacket. Design is SVC logo with Established 1984 underneath in gold. Cost of embroidery \$29, extra \$10 if logo on front and name is \$8, but waived if jacket bought from BVI. Steve F said he loved the T-shirt design and would like that embroidered if others want to go in with him to pay for the setup fees, contact him direct. Steve F, showed design for Caravan participants, an alternative to the one from Museum. Bob S and Steve R talked about new badges made up.

**Car Shows Update:** Brett R mentioned three car shows cancelled and talked about the Royal High School Car Show April 14, 2019, sign up sheet available. March 16-17 OC Fair Classic Car Show, Automotive Driving Museum March 23 all girls car show, April 28 Johnny Carson Park Spring car show.
